This weekend, the 2023 *Carnaval San Francisco* is hosting their 45th Annual Festival. This will be a 2-Day Festival from Saturday, May 27th- Sunday, May 28th, 2023, from 11:00 AM – 6:00 PM.

On Sunday, May 28th, from 9:30 AM – 2:30 PM, the Grand Parade will take place, with over 3,000 artists representing the different cultural heritages.

The Grand Parade will be held on Sunday, May 28th from 9:30 AM – 2:30 PM, located at the Gray Area/ Grand Theater (*2665 Mission Street, San Francisco, CA 94110*). Street Closures

On Sunday, when the Carnaval San Francisco Grand Parade take place. Please note that streets will be closed and there will be multiple Muni lines rerouted near the festival and parade area.

The following streets will be closed from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM:

- Mission, between 15th and 24th streets
- 15th St, between Mission and Alabama
- 24th St, between York and Mission
- Bryant, between 17th St and Cesar Chavez
- Harrison, between 15th and 16th streets
- Treat, between Harrison and Alameda
