Transit Impacts

SFMTA has recently published service impacts for the Nob Hill and SOMA neighborhoods. As the city continues to prepare for the APEC Economic Leaders' Week, Transit agencies continue to share updates on schedule and service updates, please keep in mind the information on this advisory is what is available as of this writing. Service Impacts SoMa

Muni lines will be rerouted due to the security zones placed in SOMA, from Monday, November 13th through Sunday, November 19th. All Muni riders should add commute time during these days, as ridership is expected to be high during the APEC conference. Please view the list below for the <u>affected Muni Lines</u>.

The Nob Hill neighborhood is expected to be the main conference security zone, which will in turn affect multiple Muni lines. The following Muni lines will be affected and rerouted from Tuesday, November 14th through Sunday, November 19th.

SF Bay Ferry

Golden Gate Transit

Golden Gate Transit will also have <u>service impacts</u> for routes near the Civic Center and Financial District areas. GGT highly encourages their riders to expect delays in their bus routes. GGT will not serve stops in the Civic Center area, in both the NB and SB Directions. Additionally, please view the list below of routes which will not be served from Monday, November 13th through Sunday, November 19th.

Traffic Impacts

Street Closures in SoMa

Expect traffic congestion in the SoMa neighborhood and please add travel time to your commute. The following streets will be closed as early as Monday afternoon, November 13th to Sunday November 19th.

California	Between Taylor and Stockton
Sacramento	Between Taylor and Powell
Mason	Between California and Clay

San Francisco/ Oakland Bay Bridge

Beginning Tuesday, November 14th at 5 AM through Friday, November 17th at 9 PM, the San Francisco/ Oakland bridge will <u>close two lanes</u> as an additional security measure during APEC. According to <u>Caltrans</u> the #1 left lane on Eastbound I-80 and #5 right lane on Westbound I-80 will be closed. The bridges Pedestrian and Bike Path will have controlled access. The closure will not affect transit Bus services, the Treasure Island on/off ramps, or the Freemont Street off-ramp.

Dana Bowers Vista Point (off-ramp)

Caltrans will close the Northbound US 101 Dana Bowers Vista Point off-ramp from Tuesday, November 14th through Saturday, November 18th. Cars, bicycles, or pedestrians will not be allowed on the off-ramp. According to <u>Caltrans</u>, the Golden Gate Pedestrian Path will be closed at the north end of the bridge, however, the bike path on the west side of the bridge will remain open. <u>Click here</u> to view more information on this closure.

Please be advised, although most APEC events will be happening at Moscone, additional events will be taking place in other venues not yet announced as of this writing. Additional event locations will arise and may require temporary security zones.

We highly encourage you to plan your commute ahead of time. Please monitor <u>511.org</u> for live traffic and transit alerts, <u>SFMTA.com</u> for updated street closures and MUNI reroutes, and <u>tmasfconnects.org</u> for commute alternatives.
