### **Golden Gate Transit**

*January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024*

Schedule improvements have been announced by Golden Gate Transit and will be effective Sunday January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024. ### **BART – Schedule Changes**

*January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024*

BART has recently announced [minor schedule changes](#) which will become effective Monday, January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. A few departure times have shifted. The changes made are in agreement with the [Transformation Action Plan](#) that Bay Area transit agencies are working on to enhance transit in the Bay Area.

Please note that Daly City to Berryessa (Green Line) has the biggest departure shift at seven minutes.
